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TRAINING DETAILS:

- Course Times:** **Face to Face** - 08:00 to 16:00 (Please arrive 15 minutes earlier for registration and ID verification)
Online/blended - between 4-6 hours depending on your circumstances and pace.
- Age Requirements:** All learners must be at least 15 years of age.
- Literacy and Numeracy:** Participants must have a basic level of English proficiency (written and verbal communication) and the knowledge of how to use a calculator.
- Digital Literacy:** Online learners will require access to a computer with an internet connection and the knowledge to access emails, login to the online training portal, upload documents when required and submit assessments.
In some instances, in modern mining and construction settings you may be required to enter/log information into an electronic record keeping device. Or use computerised equipment to operate various types of machinery and processes.
- Delivery:** **Option 1** - Face to Face training and assessment in a simulated workplace environment. (Min 8 candidates)
Option 2.- Online.
