Digital Literacy: Online learners will require access to a computer with an internet connection and the knowledge to access emails, login to the online training portal, upload documents when required and submit assessments.
In some instances, in modern mining and construction settings you may be required to enter/log information into an electronic record keeping device. Or use computerised equipment to operate various types of machinery and processes

Delivery: Face to Face training and assessment in a simulated workplace environment.
Online theory assessments with Face to Face practical assessment either at your workplace or our training rooms at Booragoon (minimum class numbers apply)
